Compensation: Position is unpaid. Intern will receive unlimited dance classes at the rate of \$5/class and studio rental at the rate of \$7/hr.

Term of Position

This is appointment starts May 1st, 2014 and ends September 30th, 2014. (These dates are semi-negotiable). It can be renewed based on mutual agreement. The Intern is responsible for tracking their hours and e-mailing a monthly total to Britta at <u>britta@velocitydancecenter.org</u>. The Intern may resign from post with 15 days notice.

Responsibilities include but are not limited to:

- Attend production meetings regarding Velocity produced shows
- Work with Velocity's Team to produce high quality dance performances and events.
- Work directly with Velocity's Technical Director, Resident Lighting Designer and Technical Assistant on Velocity produced shows
- As a lead Stage Hand, assist the with coordinating volunteer stage hands.
- Assist Velocity's Technical Director on other Velocity events, including the Speakeasy Series, Access Velocity events and performances, and weddings.
- Work with the Velocity staff to ensure the organization and maintenance of the facilities.
- Work with the Velocity Staff to ensure technical booth organization is maintained.
