## Application for Choreographers / Deadline October 1, 2014

This program is for movement-based artists new to making work in Seattle or who have not been making work for more than two – three years.

This three-week intensive residency offers an opportunity to receive creative, financial and administrative support, as well as rehearsal space for a specific project while working with auditioned dancers. The project simultaneously offers dancers and opportunity to bridge the gap between classroom work and performance while establishing relationships with a choreographer and other dancers.

The intensive residency will take place January 5 - 23, three hours a day (Mon-Fri). Velocity's Artist in Residence will be a choreographic advisor to all three choreographers during the process. New work resulting from the intensive will be presented by Velocity in a full produced show on the weekend of Jan 30-Feb 1, 2015 at 8PM. This year each performance will be followed by a discussion, which allow both artists and audience a greater perspective on the other's viewpoint.

## Three Choreographers will receive:

- Fully produced weekend of performances in Velocity's Founders Theater
- Three weeks of rehearsal space at Velocity:
  - o Three hours a day (Mon-Fri) + an all group showing Friday Jan 16, 6-8 pm.
- Costume stipend
- Velocity produced audition for your cast
  - o Performer audition is Saturday, November 1, 2014 from 5:30-8 pm in Founders Studio. Choreographers must be available at this time to teach material and select a cast and to stay afterwards to discuss casting and The Bridge Project.
